The Oregon State Police Forensic Services Division is recruiting for a Laboratory Director in our Pendleton Laboratory. This position is accountable for all forensic operations within the Pendleton Forensic Laboratory, including assignment and review of work performed and coordination of all functions and personnel assigned to the laboratory. Additionally, this position is expected to spend some time analyzing evidence.

The Forensic Services Division of the Oregon State Police provides the only full service forensic laboratory system in the state. We operate 6 forensic laboratories and have 126 authorized staff positions, 3 of which are assigned to the Pendleton Laboratory. Located in Northeastern Oregon, the Pendleton Laboratory provides analysis of controlled substances and physical evidence, firearms processing and local crime scene response.

We are internationally accredited through ASCLD/LAB to ISO 17025:2005 standards.
